- ❖ if SD is for **use outside Singapore** (eg. Malaysia, Hong Kong) and to be **signed in Singapore**, then sign before a Notary Public in Singapore, and follow the process requested for by the foreign recipient
  
- ❖ please note that if you have requested a Commissioner or Notary to prepare/draft the contents (your declaration) of the SD, the Commissioner or Notary may not be able to witness your signature due to conflict of interest
